PROPOSED ORDER ON EMERGENCY MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT

Ill. S. Ct. R. 361(b)(2) — phrased in the alternative

This cause coming before the Court on Appellant's Emergency Motion to Supplement the Pending Omnibus Emergency Motion, and for a Ruling on Part II Before 9:00 a.m. on August 6, 2026, the Court having considered the motion, the Supporting Record under Rule 328, and the proposed order, and being fully advised, IT IS ORDERED:

1. The motion to supplement is ALLOWED, and the matters stated in it are considered together with the Omnibus Emergency Motion.
2. Part II of the Omnibus Emergency Motion is ☐ ALLOWED ☐ DENIED. If allowed, the order entered June 17, 2026 in Circuit Court of Lake County No. 23 CF 1146 and the 180-day term of imprisonment it activated are STAYED pending this appeal; execution of the warrant issued May 28, 2026 is STAYED and the warrant RECALLED; and Appellant shall remain at liberty on recognizance under Illinois Supreme Court Rule 609(a).
3. No further proceeding shall be conducted in No. 23 CF 1146 until Appellant's verified motion for substitution of judge for cause under 725 ILCS 5/114-5(d) has been heard by a judge not named in it. That motion shall be ASSIGNED forthwith to a judge not named in it, and the assignment shall be entered of record.
4. In the alternative to the preceding paragraph, any proceeding conducted in No. 23 CF 1146 on August 6, 2026 is WITHOUT PREJUDICE to the relief sought in the Omnibus Emergency Motion and in the supplement, and no instrument file-stamped in that cause on July 23, 2026 is waived, abandoned, or denied by reason of that proceeding.
5. Appellant's verified petition under 55 ILCS 5/3-9008(a-10), and his motions under Illinois Supreme Court Rules 607(a) and 609(a), remain undecided in the circuit court.
6. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County shall TRANSMIT a copy of this order to the judge presiding in Courtroom 611 and to Appellant at his email address of record the same day it is entered.
