A new narrow request; not an amendment to FOIA 349/356 or the pending PAC review

Village of Lincolnshire FOIA Officer:

Pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq., I request the specific existing records described below. This is a noncommercial request. It is a new, narrowly targeted request and does not replace or amend FOIA 349, FOIA 356, or the pending PAC review of those matters.

RECORDS REQUESTED

CATEGORY 1 — LOCAL HIT, CONFIRMATION, LOCATE, SERVICE, AND DISSEMINATION RECORDS

Existing non-LEADS Lincolnshire records constituting, indexing, describing, or documenting any warrant hit, hit confirmation, locate, directed-message activity, dissemination, attempted service, service referral, or other-agency notification associated with the identifiers above from May 28 through July 29, 2026.

The requested local records include any hit-file or service-file cover sheet or index; local control, receipt, validation, confirmation, dissemination, operator, telecommunicator, or service log; local CAD/RMS cross-reference; local query, execution, print, reprint, or access audit; operator identifier; date and time; originating or receiving agency or ORI; and local notation showing disposition, referral, confirmation, locate, service, or dissemination.

This category does not request the substantive restricted fields of a LEADS or NCIC return. If a responsive local record contains exempt LEADS/NCIC content, redact that content and produce the agency-created cover sheet, index, dates, times, custodial information, and every other reasonably segregable nonexempt portion.

CATEGORY 2 — POLICE BUSINESS-TELEPHONE CALL-DETAIL METADATA

Existing inbound and outbound business-telephone call-detail records, not call content, sufficient to identify communications between Lincolnshire Police Department dispatch, records, warrant, command, or supervisory lines



and the Lake County Sheriff's Office, Chicago Police Department, or Chicago OEMC during these limited periods:

- May 28, 2026, 10:30 a.m. through 12:30 p.m.;
- May 29, 2026, 8:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.;
- June 6, 2026, 12:30 p.m. through 1:30 p.m.; and
- June 6, 2026, 5:20 p.m. through 6:20 p.m.

Requested fields are the calling and called agency number or line, date, start time, end time or duration, direction, extension or line identifier, and disposition where maintained. Personal or unrelated calls may be redacted or omitted.

CATEGORY 3 — OUTSIDE-JURISDICTION UNIT AND ACTIVITY RECORDS FOR THE TWO JUNE 6 WINDOWS

Existing daily activity, unit-assignment, dispatch, supervisor, officer, vehicle, AVL/GPS, mileage, or outside-jurisdiction-assistance records sufficient to identify whether a Lincolnshire officer, employee, unit, or vehicle traveled to, was assigned to, requested assistance at, or reported activity associated with 8516 W. Winona Street, Chicago, during the two June 6 time windows stated in Category 2.

CATEGORY 4 — RETENTION OR DESTRUCTION RECORDS SPECIFIC TO CATEGORIES 1 THROUGH 3

If a record responsive to Categories 1 through 3 existed but is no longer available, produce the existing destruction, purge, overwrite, loss, transfer, or retention record identifying the record category, applicable retention authority, and date of destruction or loss. This category does not ask the Village to create an explanation.

SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS

Search the Police Department, dispatch or communications function, records function, command or supervisory records, the local CAD/RMS environment, locally maintained terminal or transaction audit records, and the Village's business-telephone billing or call-detail repository. This request does not seek all records concerning me, the complete 2022 crash file, email correspondence already at issue in FOIA 349/356, raw LEADS/NCIC returns, or unrelated Village records.

PRODUCTION AND EXEMPTIONS

Please produce records electronically in native format where feasible, with useful metadata preserved. This request is noncommercial. If a record contains exempt and nonexempt material, redact only the exempt material and produce the reasonably segregable remainder.

For each withholding or redaction, please provide the written determination required by 5 ILCS 140/9, including the record or category affected, specific exemption, factual basis, responsible person's name and title, and review rights. If no responsive records are located, please identify the custodians and systems searched sufficiently to permit clarification without requiring a duplicate broad request.
