**PROPOSED ORDER ON EMERGENCY MOTION REGARDING NEWLY
PRODUCED INTERNAL COMMUNICATIONS**

This cause coming before the Court on Appellant's Emergency Motion for Leave to File a Second Supplemental Supporting Record of Newly Produced Internal Communications, the Court having considered the motion and the record filed with it, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Leave is GRANTED under Illinois Supreme Court Rules 328 and 366(a)(3) to file the Second Supplemental Supporting Record, Exhibits CC through JJ, and it is CONSIDERED in ruling on the Omnibus Emergency Motion.

The Office of the State's Attorney of Lake County and the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court shall PRESERVE, without regard to any ordinary retention or deletion schedule, all electronic mail, attachments, calendar entries, and document-management records concerning No. 23 CF 1146 and Appellant, including all material withheld or masked in the production of July 29, 2026, pending further order of this Court.
5. The Clerk of the Circuit Court of Lake County shall TRANSMIT a copy of this order to the judge presiding in Courtroom 611 and to Appellant at his email address of record the same day.
